- Session format: Presentation (1-2 people speaking), panel (2-4 people speaking) or workshop (interactive)
- Presenter name(s), title(s) and company(ies)
- Presenter bio(s) (150 words or less)

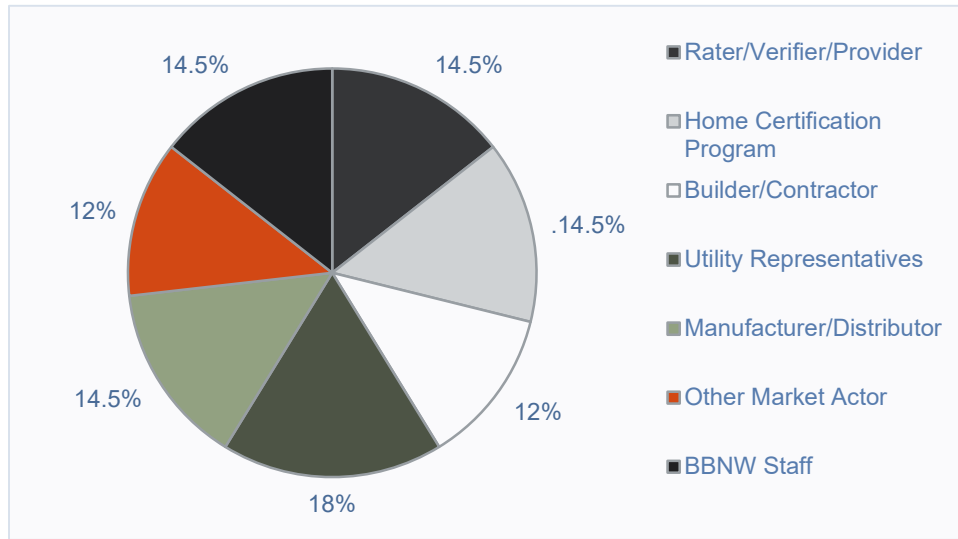
About the Conference
